Application Procedure

Applications

- Applications may be submitted from students that are members of their flight team at a National Intercollegiate Flying Association (NIFA) member school. There is no limit to the number of applications submitted from each school.
- Include a transcript (official not required) and letter(s) of recommendation (limit 2) with application.
- Completed applications must be submitted to GAMA on or before Friday, April 18, 2014. Send to:

Criteria

- The student must be a member of their college/universities flight team and enrolled and completed at least one semester at a NIFA participating institution. (www.nifa.us)
- Academic 20%: Applicant must have a 3.0 or better grade point average (on a 4.0 scale). Please submit the most recent transcript with the application.
- Aviation related extra-curricular activities - 30%: Service and contributions to NIFA, aviation clubs or aviation related activities.

- Non-aviation related extracurricular activities - 10%: Service and contributions to school and community.
- Essay Question 40%: Applicant must submit a 750-word essay explaining why they chose to pursue a career in aviation, what their future plans in aviation are, and how they plan to give back to the general aviation community. (limit one page).

Procedure

- The Dr. Harold S. Wood Award winner will be announced at the NIFA "SAFECON 2014" Awards Banquet.
- The national winner will be presented with the Dr. Harold S. Wood Award for Excellence, which includes an engraved propeller trophy and a \$2000 cash award.
