OSU Tower traffic up 5x!

A normal day in the tower at OSU can be a busy one, especially weekdays when the weather is nice with all of the corporate traffic into/out of OSU in combination with the "Buckeye" traffic, the OSU Flight School traffic. The OSU tower is one of the top 5 busiest in the State of Ohio, with average traffic at OSU running approximately 400 operations a day (an operation consists of a takeoff, landing, or any combination of the sort). Through last weekend, daily traffic was averaging between 1200-2000 operations, with maximum traffic peaking at approximately 200 operations an hour. Fortunately, one of the controllers here at OSU is only in his first week in the OSU tower, getting the "baptism-by-fire" training. The guys in the tower ask for all aircraft to read back hold short instructions, and if you have any questions, feel free to ask.

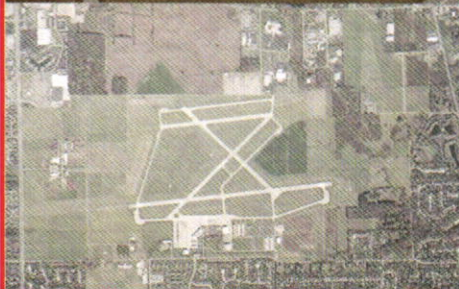
