## Answer Sheet & Instructions

1. Write your name, contestant #, and school name in the spaces provided on both the answer sheet and the test packet envelope.
2. If this test is being administered at a regional SAFECON, write the last three digits of your test serial number in the space provided at the top left corner of your answer sheet.
3. You will be given sixty (60) minutes to complete the following test. The test is made up of thirty-seven (37) multiple-choice and three (3) fill-in questions (some with multiple answers). Equipment permitted for use by contestants is: non-programmable flight computer, plotter, pen, and pencil. Basic four mathematical function (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division) calculators are also allowed. Scratch paper has been included for your use.
4. Mark your answers on the answer sheet provided by filling in the circle completely  A  B  C  D. Marks such as x's, /s, may not be scored. Only the answer sheet will be graded.
5. Choose the most correct answer. **YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN TIME AT THE END OF THE TEST TO TRANSFER YOUR ANSWERS TO THE ANSWER SHEET.** In case of ties, faster completion time takes precedence.
6. If you finish the test before time has expired, raise your hand and put your pen and/or pencil down. A judge will write your completion time on your answer sheet in the appropriate spaces. **PLACE YOUR TEST, MAP, SUPPLEMENTAL DATA PACKET, AND SCRATCH PAPER IN THE TEST PACKET ENVELOPE.** The judge will collect your answer sheet and test packet envelope separately. Remain seated, and do not talk with anyone.
7. If you do not finish early, put your pen and/or pencil down once time is called. Remain seated. Do not talk with anyone. A judge will collect your answer sheet and test packet materials separately.
8. **REMAIN QUIETLY SEATED UNTIL ALL TEST ITEMS HAVE BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR, AND YOU ARE GIVEN PERMISSION TO LEAVE.**
9. If you have any questions, ask them now before the test is started.
