As the contestant presents the lecture and the judge determines that a deduction in a particular criteria category is necessary, the judge should mark through the highest unmarked point value for the criteria category thus reducing the possible points a contestant can earn for the category. Succeeding deductions can be made in any criteria category whenever they occur during the contestant presentation by marking through the next highest unmarked point value. At the conclusion of the presentation, the highest unmarked point value in each criteria category represents the number of points earned by the contestant from the judge. Up to three judges can be used to evaluate contestants. The total points earned in each category from each judge are used to determine the ranking of the contestants. The contestant with the highest total points is the winner.
